

**Note:** During the period 12<sup>th</sup> July to 16<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 Hon'ble the Chief Justice will take up the matters from among the Single Bench Matters assigned to other Hon'ble Judges.

- Note 1: Hon'ble Judges in Division Bench shall take up their assigned Single Bench cases, if any, after finishing Division Bench cases.
- Note 2: In respect of matters not covered by the subjects allocated special order must be obtained from Hon'ble the Chief Justice.
- Note 3: Criminal conviction appeals, in which accused is/are in custody, shall be listed on top of the list.
- Note 4: All fresh matter(s) coming by way of Daily Supplementary List shall be listed before all the available single roster benches in equal proportion.
- Note 5: Besides above, any other matter may be listed before the Benches, as directed by Hon'ble the Chief Justice.
- Note 6: Mention for listing of urgent matters in the two wings of the Hon'ble High Court shall be made before the Benches dealing with the assigned roster. However, where the same roster is held by two or more Hon'ble Judges, then memos shall be placed for orders before the senior most Hon'ble Judge.
- Note 7: If request for urgent listing/hearing of case(s) is allowed, the same shall be listed in the Supplementary Cause List. Caveat, if any, filed shall be distinctively mentioned in the Regular/Supplementary Cause List.
- Note 8: Cases involving Senior Citizens (60 plus) as party or parties thereto and old cases filed up to the year 2010, shall be listed on regular basis and not kept pending in the Registry. At least five such cases per Bench shall be listed each day and while listing such matters, Registrar Judicial shall give them due preference under the caption "Senior Citizens' Cases" & "Old Cases" respectively.
- Note 9: While drafting and filing the pleadings/affidavits the relevant facts including order number, date, suit number, etc. should be mentioned. If the same are not mentioned in the pleadings, the same would be treated as defective filing. In spite of Circulars issued on this aspect and the availability of the High Court Rules, the numbering/passing Clerks are not verifying the said facts which is causing great inconvenience to the Hon'ble Courts while hearing the matters and at the time of writing orders/judgments. Hence it is impressed upon the Registry and the verifying/passing Clerks as well as the other Officers to meticulously see whether the pleadings/affidavits filed contain the relevant details and if the same are not mentioned, the case/cases shall not be numbered.
- Note 10: All the matters preferred against the orders/decisions rendered by the Commissions/Fora, which are either headed by retired Hon'ble Judges of the Supreme Court/retired Hon'ble Chief Justices of the High Courts/retired Hon'ble Judges of High Courts or the Member of the Commissions/Fora, shall be posted for hearing before the Roster Division Bench including the pending matters.
- Note 11: Contempt matters shall be listed in terms of the Circular No. 22 dated 30.05.2020.
- Note 12: Fresh cases (including fresh applications for grant of urgent interim directions) for next day listing, shall be listed in the Supplementary Cause List.
- Note 13: Five Final Hearing matters shall be listed per day before each bench in chronological order as per the roster.
- Note 14: Part Heard matters shall be listed as per High Court order No. 873/RG dated 10.02.2021 read with 239/GS dated 01.09.2020.
- Note 15: Fresh matters for admission and urgent applications shown in the supplementary cause list shall be taken up at the beginning of the second half of the day, whereafter the concerned Benches shall take up other cases from the Advance List and remaining cases of the Supplementary List.
- Note 16: Special Bench(s), if any constituted in addition to the Roster Benches, shall be convened in second half of the Friday.
- Note 17: If the listed matters related to personal liberties are not taken up for any reason in first half of the day in that event these matters shall be taken up by the concerned Benches at the beginning of the post lunch-session as per the convenience of the concerned roster bench.
