- Note 1:** In case any clarification regarding listing of the case(s) before any Bench is required, the necessary orders shall be solicited by the Registrar Judicial, Srinagar/Jammu, from Hon'ble the Chief Justice for assignment of such case(s).
- Note 2:** If for any reason, Hon'ble Judge sitting in the Division Bench has to sit in Single Bench, in that case, the Registrar Judicial, Srinagar/Jammu, shall solicit appropriate orders from Hon'ble the Chief Justice regarding listing of the cases.
- Note 3:** Hon'ble Judges in Division Bench shall take up their assigned Single Bench cases, if any, after finishing Division Bench cases.
- Note 4:** In respect of matters not covered by the subjects allocated special order must be obtained from Hon'ble the Chief Justice.
- Note 5:** Criminal conviction appeals, in which accused is/are in custody, shall be taken up by the Bench on priority.
- Note 6:** Mention for listing of urgent matters in the two wings of the Hon'ble High Court shall be made before the Benches dealing with the assigned roster. However, where the same roster is held by two or more Hon'ble Judges, then memos shall be placed for orders before the senior most Hon'ble Judge.
- Note 7:** If request for urgent listing/hearing of case(s) is allowed, the same shall be listed in the Supplementary Cause List. Caveat, if any, filed shall be distinctively mentioned in the Regular/Supplementary Cause List.
- Note 8:** Cases involving Senior Citizens (60 plus) as party or parties thereto and old cases filed up to the year 2010, shall be listed on priority. Registrar Judicial shall give them due preference under the caption "Senior Citizens' Cases" & "Old Cases" respectively.
- Note 9:** Special Bench(s), if any constituted in addition to the Roster Benches, shall be convened in second half of the Friday.
- Note 10:** If the listed matters related to personal liberties are not taken up for any reason in first half of the day in that event these matters shall be taken up by the concerned Benches at the beginning of the post lunch-session as per the convenience of the concerned roster bench.
- Note 11:** First ten cases in the list before the Bench(s) shall not be ordinarily adjourned.
- Note 12:** To ensure disposal of old cases pending up to the year 2002 in both the wings of the High Court, it is impressed upon both the Registrars Judicial to list 10 cases each before every Single Benches commencing from the week commencing 12th December, 2022. In the event these cases remain pending on the said date, same shall be kept on board till these cases are disposed of.
- Note 13:** Declined matters of the Benches shall be listed before other available Roster Benches.
- Note 14:** The urgency memo may be placed to the senior-most Judge holding the Court singly as per Roster.
- Note 15:** All hearing matters exclusively on Thursday.
- Note 16:** Registrars Judicial of both the wings of the High Court shall solicit orders from Hon'ble the Chief Justice for listing of cases which are to be heard by the Commercial Division Benches constituted in terms of Section 4 of the Commercial Courts Act, 2015.
